Course Purpose: The goal of this course is to provide employees with the knowledge and resources needed to properly generate, accumulate and dispose of hazardous waste. The course is intended for anyone who will be generating hazardous waste, including Lab Managers and PIs.

Course Objectives:

After completing this course, learners will be able to:

- Determine if waste is hazardous
- Recall the hazardous waste characterization criteria
- Acknowledge the importance of chemical compatibility
- Select the correct type of container for a given chemical
- Demonstrate how to properly label hazardous waste
- Recognize a Satellite Accumulation Area (SAA)
- Recognize how to properly store hazardous waste in an SAA
- Demonstrate how to properly fill out an accumulation log
- Identify how to properly fill out a requisition
- Recall how and where to dispose of items that fall into the special waste category
- Recall what the Waste Review Process involves
- Identify the resources available to assist hazardous waste generators
