- Has the ability to communicate, perform problem solving and provide customer service
- Understanding of the requirement to comply with LBNL implementation of DOE health and safety policies and other applicable Federal, State, and local fire, health, safety, emergency-preparedness, pollution-prevention, and environmental protection policies.
