Learning Objectives:

After completing this training, participants will be able to participate in semiannual chain checks of the accelerator personnel protection systems

Training Requirements: Must have read and understand 88-OPS-PRO-001 in its entirety, demonstrate proficiency functioning as a tester in all three positions (in Control Room, inside of a total exclusion area (TEA), and outside of a TEA) on at least 3 procedure attachments (chain check tests for unique TEAs)
