EHS0478 ~ Radiation Protection - Radiological Practical Training

Course Syllabus

Subject Category: Radiation Protection

Course Length: 1 Hour

Delivery Mode: One-on-One Schedule: As Needed

Course Purpose: To provide practical hands-on training commensurate with a job assignment that requires an employee to work with dispersible radioactive material (> 10CFR835 Appendix D levels) or work in a posted Contamination Area (CA), High Contamination Area (HCA), Airborne Radioactivity Area (ARA) or High Radiation Area (HRA). This course is designed to evaluate an employee's work practices, survey techniques, donning and doffing of protective clothing, and their responses to both normal and off normal conditions. This course is mandatory prior to commencing work in a CA, HCA, ARA, or HRA under any Radiological Work Authorization (RWA). Other radiation protection courses may also be required and will be specified in the RWA covering the work.

Course Objectives: After completing this training, you will be able to:

- Properly select and use radiation instruments.
- Properly select and use of contamination instruments.
- Properly select and inspect protective clothing.
- Properly don and doff protective clothing.
- Properly document survey results.
- Take proper actions to take in an off normal situation (elevated radiation levels, contamination found).
- Properly post job personnel surveys.
