Course Purpose: The goal of this course is to prevent hepatitis B illness in workers who may be exposed to materials that may contain the hepatitis B virus (HBV) by providing workers with information to support their decision regarding receipt of the HBV vaccination.

- Recognize HBV health effects
- Identify occupational exposures and procedures
- Identify the benefits, safety and risks of vaccination
